Perriam, adds, “The solution implemented by TCG will be integrated with our accounting system - Quickbooks - which means that when we are trawling through profitability by property, for example, if there is a query on any particular cost, at the click of a button you can access the original paperwork to clarify any uncertainty or add any information.”

The software will ensure that the internal communication and the recording and documenting process is improved, allowing BGV Property Management’s staff ease of access to all office paperwork. The workflow product gets the information around the business in the correct order – obtaining approvals from the relevant people at the relevant time. This is particularly effective when circulating supplier invoices throughout the company.
